### 1 Cor 14.26

1. What are the key things you remember from the sermon on Sunday?
2. **Heb 12.22-24**
  - We are God's masterpiece: *“If we have an invitation from the King, we should make the effort to turn up together and make it special and honourable”*
  - Why is it so easy to become flippant about church?
  - What can help us avoid that?
3. **1 Pet 2.9-10**
  - *“We are a dynasty of unsurpassed greatness”; “We are born rebels, but Jesus makes us priests and kings”*
  - How often are you consciously aware of this?
  - What does being *priests* look like in everyday life?
    - How about being *kings*?
4. **1 Cor 14.1-5**
  - *“The gifts of the Holy Spirit, in particular tongues and prophecy are not for YOUR thing, but should be brought for others out of love”*
    - When do you consider what you can bring as a contribution in worship - *before* we gather, *when* we gather, *after*(!) we gather?!
    - What can YOU do to grow in this area?
