1. **Freedom:** Most people want to be free so that they can do whatever they want. 3. **Hindrance from the power of the Holy Spirit:** David gave three examples of things that may hinder us from the power of the Holy Spirit, can we mention these things? Explain how these things can act as hindrances to our walk with God. Romans 15:3, Hebrews 12: 1-2
