Acts 10.9-23

[NB: All questions are suggestions; the aim is fruitful discussion of Sunday's sermon, rather than mere repetition - ie, learning between us how to put it into practice]

1. What struck you most from Martin's sermon on Sunday?
2. 'POSITIONING':
 - The catalyst for change was that Peter went to pray...
 - What might prevent us from this kind of thing being part of our everyday lifestyle, like Peter?
 - Does anyone have stories of how God has spoken in these everyday, 'normal' moments in the past?
3. 'PERSPECTIVE':
 - God's perspective is often unexpected and challenging...
 - What stops us from expecting the unexpected, and what can we do to help that?
 - Share stories of what God might be saying to you about your future - whether that is to stay or to go, or that you don't know (an equally legitimate position to share and receive prayer for!).
4. 'PARTICIPATION':
 - The Lord speaks and guides as we go...
 - Pray for each other, based on what you have shared, asking for further guidance, clarification and encouragement.
 - Let us all expect the unexpected and prepare ourselves for many surprises from within our Beacon family!
