Psalm 24.1; Gen 1.26-28

[NB: All questions are suggestions; the aim is fruitful discussion of Sunday’s sermon, rather than mere repetition - ie, learning between us how to put it into practice]

1. What struck you most from Steve’s sermon?
2. Had you considered “*Humanity’s Job Description*” before? Did this change anything for you?
3. “*People want the kingdom without the king*” (Mark Sayers) - what evidence do we see of this in society around us?
4. Discuss the different examples Steve gave of what it means to be “God’s Caretakers” in our everyday lives:
 - *Home*
 - *Work/School*
 - *World*
 - *Time*
 - *Money [Luke 12.32-34; 2 Cor 9.6-8]*
 - *...share stories of when you have had to make decisions for Jesus in these areas.*
